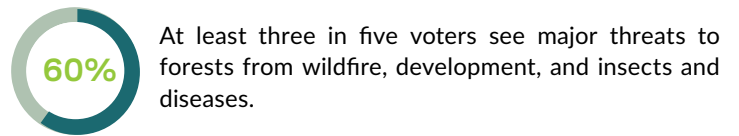
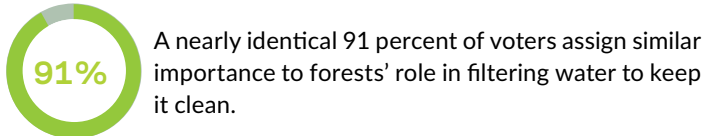
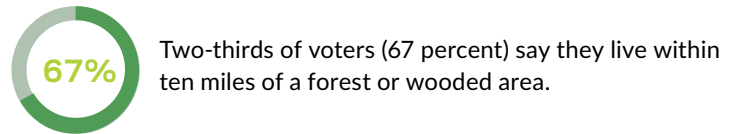
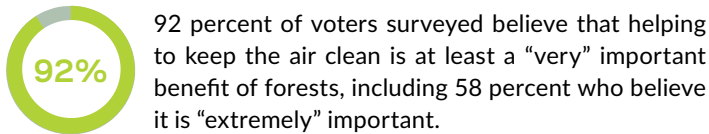


# Ten-Year Progress Overview

## Americans Understand Threats Facing American Forests

Public awareness and understanding around the need for and benefits of urban and community forestry is one of the greatest opportunities for support for improving the health of urban forestry in the coming decade. Based on a nationwide survey

of voters to assess key public perceptions and values related to forests, voters report strongly valuing the nation's forests for its sources of clean air and water (Public Opinion Strategies, 2011).



## Urban and Community Forestry Progress Overview (Amount and percent change between 2005 and 2014)

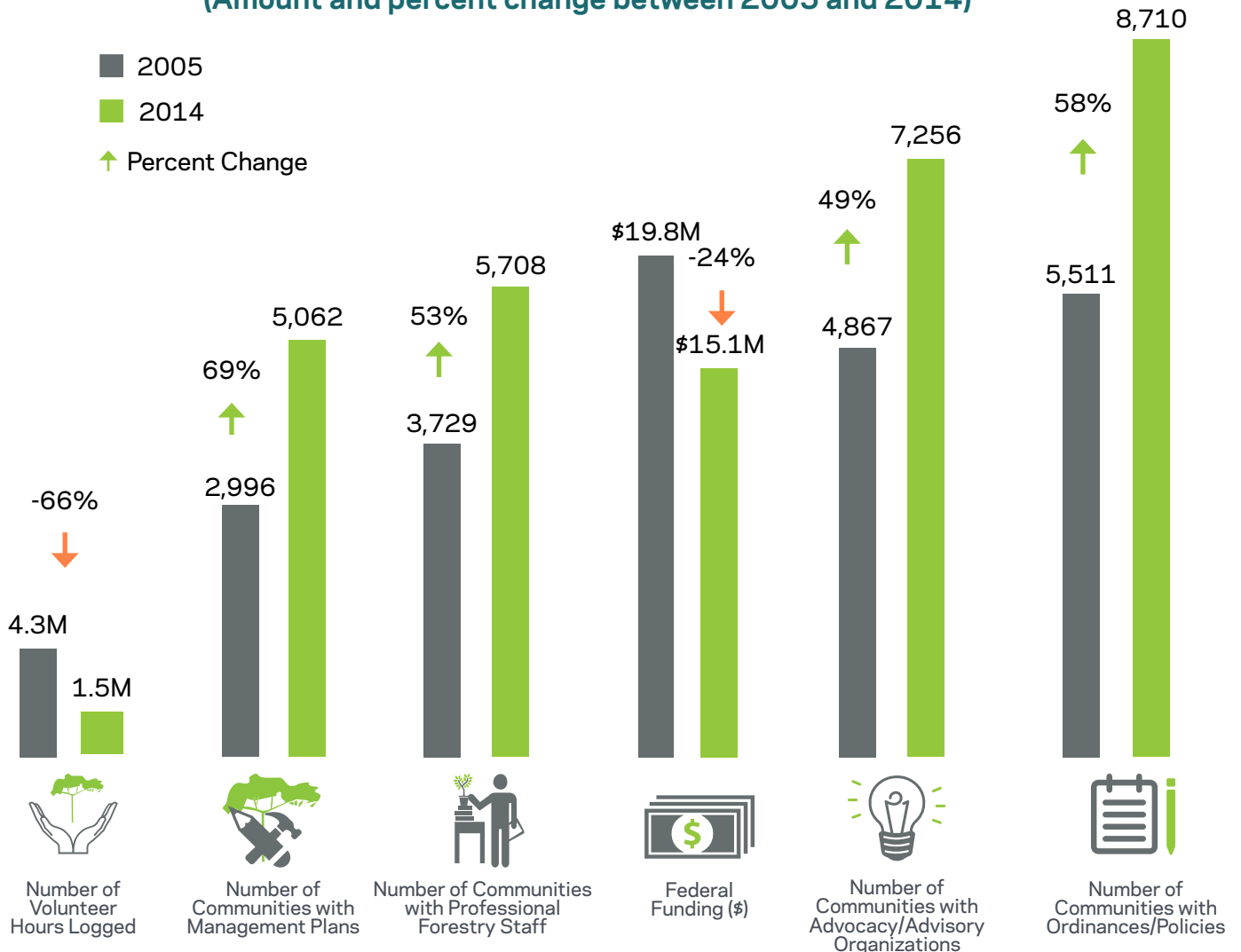


Figure 1: USDA Forest Service Federal Program: Urban and Community Forestry Assistance Program, Community Accomplishment Report System for Urban and Community Forestry (CARS)
